"UNPLANNED"

Forwarded by Bishop Patrick from John Edwards and the Nottingham 40 days of Life Group:

The pro life film, 'Unplanned', made such a positive (and unexpected) impact in the USA on its release in the spring. It is the true story of one woman, Abby Johnson, who was the manager of an abortion clinic and a spokesperson for the abortion provider Planned Parenthood, until she had an experience which led to a complete change of heart. She is now one of the foremost advocates in the USA for the unborn child, and she actively helps women and men who have been involved in abortions to find healing.

Those who have seen the film say it is well made, compassionate, and sensitive.

The film has not yet been released in the UK, as the producers have met opposition from the leading distributors, who do not think that it will be commercially successful. We would like this film to be shown in at least one cinema in Nottingham, as we believe it will help inform this important debate, in an appropriately sensitive way.

To this end, I am sending you a petition, and related materials, and would ask you to make the petition available for your parishioners to sign at the back of your church for three weekends.

After the third weekend, please return the completed petition forms to the address at the bottom of the sheets. The deadline for return of the petitions is 19th November 2019.

National Day of Prayer & Fasting For Life

On Saturday 28th September please pray and fast for the end of abortion and euthanasia. **Also pray that anti-life 'Buffer Zones' will be ruled illegal**. Your prayer and fasting is urgently needed.

<u>Prayer:</u> We are asking people to say a Rosary (or an extra Rosary if you say it daily already).

You could also offer an extra effort such as going to Mass (or an extra Mass) on the day, or going to Adoration. You can even pray before a closed tabernacle if Adoration is not available near you.

<u>Fasting</u>: Fast from all food except bread and water for the day

Or: Fast from a particular food or luxury, e.g. chocolate, alcohol, cigarettes, TV. Fast from whatever you can given your state of health etc,
