Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Lent Today is the halfway mark of the Sundays of Lent. This Sunday is known as **Laetare Sunday** for the first word of the Entrance Antiphon is 'rejoice'. **It is a Sunday of Joy, a foretaste of Easter Joy**. The Church's liturgy this Sunday invites us to retrace one of the fundamental dynamics of our baptismal re-birth through the Gospel account of the healing of the 'man born blind'.

It is the passage from the darkness of sin and of error to the Light of God, who is the Risen Christ.

WE OFFER In the Presentation of the Offerings and Eucharistic Prayer, we offer as one, taking part in the sacrifice of praise, for the Mass remembers the Last Supper as Sacrament, represents the Crucifixion as Sacrifice, and looks forward to the Resurrection as Celebration.

What do we call the bread and the wine?

Before the Consecration, when the Celebrant says 'Take this, all of you, and eat of it...' and 'Take this, all of you, and drink from it...' it is bread and wine. But after the Consecration it is the Body of Christ under the appearance of bread and the Blood of Christ under the appearance of wine, and so we should call it the Body of Christ' or 'the Sacred Host' and the Blood of Christ or 'the Precious Blood'.
