I'm delighted to be able to report more progress in our efforts to repair and improve St Mary Crowned Church. The architect has produced revised plans for toilets and a refreshment area, and tenders have been sought, with the plan of presenting them to the necessary diocesan committees at their meeting in June. We have been blessed with kind donations

towards the work, including a very generous legacy of £179,772.61 from the late Anne Walsh, may she rest in peace. Further donations are earnestly invited, and cheques may be made payable to "St Mary RC Glossop RCP". Receiving The Eucharist this Lent:

Part 5: The Liturgy of the Eucharist (cont'd) What do we do when we get back to our seats?

We should kneel or sit and make our thanksgiving, either by singing the hymn or by praying quietly, maybe saying:

'O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment thine,' or:

'Lord Jesus, make me a better person, more considerate towards others, more honest with myself and more faithful to you.'

Today is Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

during which we commemorate Christ's entry into Jerusalem for the completion of the Paschal Mystery. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, which reveals God's Love as lavish and limitless, as shown in the events unfolding before our eyes. His passion is the outcome of His compassion, and His whole life is wonderful witness to God's Love. "He did not cling to His equality with God but

emptied himself to assume the condition of a slave." (Phil 2:6)

Jesus came to serve, not to be served. This week offers us the chance for transformation, especially in our weakness. The experience of these past three years has helped us all to name our own personal weakness, and as Richard Rohr reminds us:

"All great spirituality is about what we do with pain. If we do not transform our pain, we will transmit it to those around us."

Many of our parishioners, within their various ministries, have been helping to prepare for Holy Week for several months.

You are warmly invited to join us for all three Triduum Liturgies – Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil.

It is an ancient tradition for God's people to gather and celebrate the Easter mysteries. They are the highlight of our Liturgical Year and can, in many ways, be seen together as one liturgy, as we accompany Our Lord Jesus in his Passion, Death and Resurrection.
