FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER 2023 – 30th APRIL ALSO GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Easter, Good Shepherd Sunday

Jesus said: "The one who enters through the gate is the shepherd of the flock; the gatekeeper lets him in, the sheep hear his voice, one by one he calls his own sheep and leads them out.

When he has brought out his flock, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow because they know his voice." *In 10: 2-4*

Christ's sheepfold is the Church. In the Church He bestows on us His life in the Sacraments, His word in the teaching that she gives us, all the riches of His grace to light up our way and uphold our steps as we go forward to our heavenly home; through her He acts as the one Shepherd of our souls. Appointed to lead the flock, Peter gave his life for those entrusted to his care, and ever since then the priestly ministry has assured the continuous presence in the Church of Him who remains the true Shepherd of our souls.

The Fourth Sunday of Easter marks the Anniversary of the **World Day of Prayer for Vocations** instituted by Pope Paul VI.

We pray today for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
