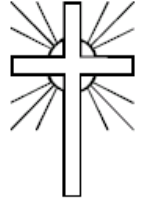
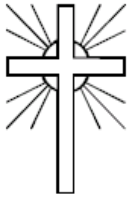

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY 2024 – 26TH MAY

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity

Today's feast invites us to live in the awareness of the presence of the Triune God within us: *The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.*

The mystery of the Holy Trinity, a doctrine enunciated by the ecumenical councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity and the greatest mystery of our Faith, namely, that there are Three Divine Persons, sharing the same Divine nature in one God. *"There is one God, who has three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God."*

The Importance to us in our Christian lives:

All prayers in the Church begin in the Name of the Holy Trinity and end glorifying the Trinity.

All Sacraments are administered (we are baptised, confirmed, anointed, our sins are forgiven, our marriage blessed, and our Bishops, priests and deacons ordained) in the name of the Holy Trinity. *We bless ourselves, and the priest blesses us, in the name of the Holy Trinity.*

The Events Committee write,

We have organised a trip to Our Lady's Shrine at Ladyewell in Fulwood, Preston, on Thursday 11th July 2024. A minibus will leave Glossop at 9.30am arriving at Ladyewell at 11am, returning from Ladyewell at 3pm, and arriving back in Glossop at 4.30pm. There will be 7 places to be allocated to St Mary's parishioners, and 7 to those from All Saints. The cost will be £20 per head. The minibus won't make any stops on the way. Fr Martin is expected to travel and will celebrate Holy Mass at Ladyewell.

A talk will be offered giving a history of the Shrine. Visitors are asked to take a packed lunch, and drinks will be available at the cafe there. Places on the bus will be allocated to those who contact Jenny Cieslik at St Mary's and Peter Greenhalgh at All Saints, and these will be allocated on a first come basis with a payment of £20 in cash.

We will also be running the *WHY? Course* on Sunday 21st July and Saturday 3rd August, running the three sessions on the same day on each of these occasions, with meals included. There will be a **planning meeting** for the *WHY? Course* on **Sunday 2nd June at 5pm in St Mary's Hall**, where light refreshments will be available. If you are interested in helping with the course please do come along to the meeting.

Next weekend is 'Labels Sunday' and we will once again invite you to wear a name label and to pray for a fellow parishioner.
